## SOCIOLOGY MAJOR, B.A. - 2024-2025

To qualify for admission into the Sociology major, students must complete the pre-major courses with a UC grade-point average of 2.3. Courses in the preparation for the major will not be included in the pre-major GPA computation but must be taken for a letter grade and will influence the overall major GPA. Acceptance into the pre-major does not guarantee admission to full major status. Upon satisfactory completion of the pre-major courses, students must complete a change of major petition, available through contacting the Sociology Undergraduate Advisors.

Students must complete all pre-major & preparation for the major courses for letter grades and achieve the minimum GPA requirements.

Courses in the pre-major must be completed with a grade of "C-" or higher.
