have seen the disparate impact of COVID-19 on people of color and immigrants throughout the United States.

We stand in solidarity with our Black graduate and undergraduate students, faculty, and staff who experience trauma, secondary trauma, exclusion, and isolation from racism. As a department, we commit to reflecting on and seeking out best practices on how to improve our support of all Black members of our department and the UCSB campus community.

We stand with those seeking justice in the streets of Minneapolis and across the globe.
